All applicants must submit six (6) copies of this application, six (6) copies of their law school transcript, and six (6) copies of their LSAT scores, to Rocky Mountain Mineral Law Foundation, 9191 Sheridan Blvd., Suite 203, Westminster, CO 80031. Students at the University of Alberta and University of Calgary, as well as LLM students, are exempted from submitting LSAT documents. First-year law school students must submit their undergraduate transcripts. **Photocopies are acceptable.**
3. Letters of reference from two individuals who can speak from personal knowledge concerning the applicant's character, ability, and potential to make a significant contribution to the field of natural resources law should be sent directly to the Rocky Mountain Mineral Law Foundation, Attn: Scholarship Committee. If presently in law school, one reference preferably should be from a law school professor.
4. All documents necessary to complete this application must be received by the Rocky Mountain Mineral Law Foundation by **October 1, 2010**. Applications received after this date will not be considered.
